

LEATHER

All our leather furniture is made from leather of the highest quality, so called full grain from Italy and South America. The products are treated in different ways to get the desired look. The furniture is made with metal or wooden frames. The spring system usually consists of elastic bands or so called nozag springs. Seats and backs are made with filling of foam, polyether or certified down and feather. Recommended for indoor use.

MAINTENANCE

In order for the leather to retain colour and function, it is important to take care of it. Vacuum the furniture with a soft brush. Stains should be wiped off immediately before being absorbed into the leather. Never use strong detergents but use a soft cloth with lukewarm water or a leather cleaner. On small scratches and abrasions, you can try to rub with a clean finger. Never expose the leather to strong sunlight and do not place the furniture near a heat source.

To maintain the shape and appearance of this furniture, it is necessary to regularly puff up and shake the cushions lightly to distribute the filling in the cushion. On some models you can pick out the inner cushion and turn it over. Seats and cushions filled with down require a little more maintenance than synthetic cushions, but if you take care of them, they will look good and be comfortable for many years.

PURE DYE, NATURAL WASHED & DESTROYED BLACK

These leathers are leather completely without topcoat, so-called full aniline, which makes them very soft and flexible. This also makes the leather more sensitive to stains. The look is deep and natural and there may be colour changes. The animal's own structure, insect bites and scars are left visible. Unlike other leathers, this type of leather should not be treated with leather cream. If you do that, it loses its typical character. Therefore, you should instead impregnate these leathers with Leathermasters Natural Protection.

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NUBUCK

Nubuck is a sanded and matt leather, which has a very soft and smooth surface. As the shiny, protective surface of the leather has been sanded off, the leather is very sensitive to dirt and stains and therefore it is important that the furniture is treated with Leather Natural Protection before it is used and regularly thereafter. Unlike other leathers, this type of leather should not be treated with leather cream. If you do that, it loses its typical character. Therefore, you should instead impregnate nubuck with Leathermasters Natural Protection. When cleaning, use Nubuck cleaner.

VINTAGE CIGAR

The leather colour "vintage cigar" is a specially treated leather to bring out the worn and old look. This leather should be treated no more than 2 times / year. Cracks in the paint occur more or less, which makes each piece of furniture feel unique.

BUFFALO LEATHER

A unique vintage leather made by artisans using traditional methods on buffalo leather from Italy. The leather is suitable for the vintage look and feel of our products, the worn look with natural marks, such as healed scars, scratches, and wrinkles. The unique surface of the leather is created by different treatments in several different steps. The leather must be cleaned and treated regularly to maintain its character. Clean with Soft cleaner approx. 6-12 times/year and treat with Leather Protection cream 2-4 times/year.

TITANIC ESPRESSO/ANTHRACITE

A high-quality, lightly sanded, semi-aniline leather from Italy that is soft and comfortable. The leather must be cleaned and treated regularly to maintain its character. Clean with Soft cleaner approx. 6-12 times/year and treat with Leather Protection cream 2-4 times/year.

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FUDGE/WHISKEY SPITFIRE

A high-quality, semi-aniline leather from South America that is soft and comfortable.

The leather is specially treated to bring out a slightly worn look. The leather must be cleaned and treated regularly to maintain its character. Clean with Soft cleaner approx. 6-12 times/year and treat with Leather Protection cream 2-4 times/year.

CHOCOLATE BROWN/MOUNTAIN BLACK

A semi-aniline leather where each part of the leather has gone through a tanning process in 14 different stages including sand polishing and natural oils, to give it a beautiful finish. The leather is not lacquered, but only has a thin wax that protects against stains, which makes the leather breathe easily. The leather must be cleaned and treated regularly to maintain its character. Clean with Soft cleaner approx. 6-12 times/year and treat with Leather Protection cream 2-4 times/year.

SAFARI BLACK/SAFARI GREY

A slightly thicker, lightly sanded full-grain leather with a matte and soft surface. The leather must be cleaned and treated regularly to maintain its character. Clean with Soft cleaner approx. 6-12 times/year and treat with Leather Protection cream 2-4 times/year.

VINTAGE BLACK

A full-grain, covered colour leather with a bit of structure and a slightly worn appearance. The leather must be cleaned and treated regularly to maintain its character. Clean with Soft cleaner approx. 6-12 times/year and treat with Leather Protection cream 2-4 times/year.
